Summary:

Triple S Steel is seeking a motivated Production Equipment Operator to join our business. This is a steel production equipment operator position that is responsible for properly reading and executing work orders in a timely manner to meet customer requirements. In addition to that this person is responsible for maintaining safety standards and achieving daily productivity goals, and meeting quality requirements. The operator will also be able to set up and operate a CNC oxy/plasma machine, and use an overhead crane to load/unload steel plates, verify that finished products meet specifications and maintain a clean and safe work environment.

Job Responsibilities:

- Follow Triple-S-Steel safe methods of work at all times, and immediately advise the supervisor of any unsafe conditions.
- Manipulate, cut and/or form raw materials according to work orders to meet customer requirements.
- Ability to interpret CAD drawings, symbols, and notes.
- Ability to measure materials to assure conformance with design specifications on the correct machine, with the correct material type, stock size, and dimensions.
- Ability to transfer appropriate data onto materials.
- Ability to keep an accurate record of daily operations and material usage.
- Safely and properly move steel to and from storage or production areas, loading docks, delivery vehicles, by hand, forklift, overhead crane or other equipment. Attach slings, hooks, or other devices to lift material and guide loads; to climb onto vehicles to tie down and release material being loaded. This is continuous daily activity.
- Apply proper building techniques.
- Configure load based on planned route including multiple stops.
- Maximize load capacity on trailers without sacrificing safety.
- Maintain and safely operate all assigned tools and equipment, including but not limited to tape measure, caliper, hammer, pallet trucks, banding machine, micrometer, beam hooks, plate lifting clamps, forklift, overhead crane and personal protective equipment.
- Determine safety issues pertaining to equipment and promptly report them.
- Use clear vision to judge near and far distance to maintain awareness of ongoing work activities of other employees.
- Work indoors and outdoors in all kinds of weather conditions including precipitation, cold/heat, high wind, and turbulent conditions. The Production Equipment Operator will be regularly exposed to the typical weather of the local area.
- Attend all required company meetings.
- Other duties may be assigned.
