The responsibility of a Truss Assembler is to accurately and efficiently assemble the components for trusses, which are structural components used in construction to support roofs, floors, or bridges. This position involves working with various materials such as wood or metal to construct trusses according to specifications and design plans for residential, commercial, and industrial construction projects.

### **Job Responsibilities:**

1. Must be able to read, review, and interpret construction plans, blueprints, and specifications to understand truss design requirements.

8. Keep accurate records of materials used, time spent, and issues encountered during the assembly process.
