The Mechanic/Technician position will involve but not be limited to the following duties:

- Manage all aspects of repairs, service & maintenance procedures assigned to him/her.
- Communicate with service writer and customer to ensure understanding of repair or service needs and consistently deliver reliable, safe & lasting repairs to customers
- Keep accurate and detailed reports of all services performed, material used & time required to perform repairs or services.
- Perform service, maintenance, repair and overhauls in accordance with manufacturers' recommendations
- Ensures that safety is the highest priority in the workplace
- Performs repairs in response to maintenance requests, in shop or in field locations
- Repairs equipment, removing/replacing components
- Uses diagnostic procedures and test equipment to identify and correct equipment faults
- Performs mechanical, hydraulic, pneumatic, electric, and electronic analyses and diagnoses
- Operates shop equipment including cranes, welders, compressors, presses, grinders, heavy hand tools, and tire servicing equipment
- Lifts, moves and/or installs parts and assemblies safely, using basic tooling and PPE
- Assists other members of the team as required
- Performs other duties as assigned

The ideal candidate will possess the following essential requirements:

- Demonstrated ability to follow through on instruction, work with minimal supervision, use required computer/telephone applications
- High school diploma/GED
- 5 years experience in repairing and maintaining construction & landscape equipment.
- Knowledge and proper use of special tools/equipment required to perform assigned maintenance tasks
- In possession of proper tooling to perform repair tasks in a safe & effective manner
- Must know theory and principles of engine operations, electrical systems, hydraulic systems, accessories and components
- Must be able to lift at least 50 lbs.
